SADDA NATIONAL TITLING EVENT



1. QUALIFYING LEVEL

Qualifiers (Freestylers & Dogs) have to be in Novice Level (and upwards) in order to qualify to take part in the Nationals. (only the scores from the Novice class, and upwards will contribute towards the scoring system)

2. CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Both Musical Freestyle and Heelwork To Music classes will be accommodated and entertained within the qualifying criteria.

3. ROUTINE LENGTH

To take part in the SADDA National Titling Event, the length of the routine being showcased in the Nationals must be between 2:30min and 3:30min

4. CATEGORIES

For qualifying in the SADDA National event, the following Categories will be entertained :

Adult singles : Adult Golden Oldies (singles) : Junior Singles

5. AMOUNT OF COMPETITORS

The SADDA Nationals will accommodate 12 routines only (it could be HTM or MF), by 12 different dogs (the same handler might qualify with 2 different dogs)

6. REGIONAL AND NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The Regional Champion from each Region will be acknowledged and receive the Title of SADDA REGIONAL CHAMPION, However, The aim and objective of the National Championships is to determine the "best Freestyler on the Day", and the team that wins the National Championships on the day will be awarded the Title of SADDA NATIONAL CHAMPION.

7. PLACINGS

On the day of the SADDA National Championships, only two awards will be handed out, that of :

SADDA NATIONAL CHAMPION : SADDA NATIONAL CHAMPION RUNNER-UP

The two winners will receive rosettes, prizes and a sash for the human, and of course their photos will be posted on the website for the period of a year.

8. JUDGES DECISION

On the day, the Judges Decision is final. Where there might be two judges who judge the National Event, their two scores will be added together, and divided by 2 in order to reach a final mark.

Highest scoring team wins, second highest scoring team is runner-up.

9. DATE AND VENUE FOR NATIONAL EVENT

The proposed date for the SADDA NATIONAL TITLING EVENT is March each year. For 2016, the 1st SADDA National Titling event is planned for March of that year, and will be held in Cape Town. Qualifiers will be notified towards the end of 2015 so that plans can be made for travelling and accommodation. The SADDA National Titling Event will then "rotate" around the country in years to come, with each region having the opportunity to host the National Event

10. ENTRY FEES

Those who qualify to take part in the SADDA Nationals do not have to pay an entry fee for that specific event.

The balance of the Rules, Regulations and Guidelines apply.

Each SADDA member will therefore have the opportunity to take part in 7 Titling Event. You might have to travel to get to all 7, if you want to, or you might opt to just take part in those within your Region and the Digital competitions. A log of all the scores, legs and titles achieved during the year will be kept. *(this log will be transparent throughout the year, and will be posted on the website)*

At the end of the year, the THREE HIGHEST SCORES earned by each dog during each routine which he/she showcased during the year at SADDA Titling Events will be taken into consideration. These three highest scores will be added up to get one total.

Teams qualifying to take part in the Nationals will be "divided" into the following sections, as follows :-

1. The **top scoring Adult Singles team from each Region** will automatically qualify to take part in the Nationals, so that each Region enjoys some form of representation at the Nationals. **(3 teams)**
2. The 7 top scoring Adult teams, within the entire country, will qualify to take part in the Nationals **(7 teams).**
3. The **1** top scoring Golden Oldie team within the country, will qualify to take part in the Nationals
4. The **1** top scoring Junior team within the country, will qualify to take part in the Nationals, **HOWEVER**, if there is no Junior team who is at least at Novice level, and who might qualify, then the 2 top scoring Golden Oldie teams will qualify to take part.
